Reported Heavy Battle Near Puerto Padre—
Severe Losses—Rumored Killing of General
Marmol—Nothing Reliable, However.

HAVANA, June 12, 1899.

Reports have been received here of a severe engagement between the government troops and the insurrectionists at Puerto Padre. The losses are given at hundreds. Among those reported killed is General Marmol. Reliable information, however, is wanting of this engagement.

Captain Paaf, of the Dutch war vessel Soembing, was drowned, at Kingston, Jamaica, on the 1st instant.
