THE QUAKER CITY is seized again, not because it is still suspected that she is to go to Cuba or to sail in the "Cuban Navy" against Spanish commerce, but because possibly she may be going to help along a revolution somewhere else. These neutrality laws are handy things. If anything can ever commend to the American people the looseness and insufficiency of the English neutrality laws it will be their experience of the results that flow from the stringency of our own.
