**Death of One of Maximilian's Ministers—
Warm Weather—Capture of a Schooner
Laden with War Materials.**

HAVANA, June 19, 1869.

Jose Lacunza, one of Maximilian's Ministers, died this morning of vomito.

The weather is very warm.

The Spanish war steamer Fernando Catolica brought into this port to-day the schooner Lahave, captured on the high seas, near Cape Maisi. The schooner was from Boston, and the officers claim that she was going to St. Mary's, or Hayti, or Kingston. Her cargo consisted of thirteen Parrott guns and two field pieces, 3,000 shells 1,400 barrels powder and much other ammunition. The vessel was detained until she is determined a legal prize.
