UNITED STATES MARSHAL'S OFFICE.

The War on Cuba—Further Arrests—The Prisoners Remanded.

Ralph Herman and Samuel C. Berman, who were arrested in Jersey City on Friday night, on a charge of having been engaged in an expedition against Cuba, were brought down to the United States Marshal's Office yesterday to have the question of bail settled. They were required to find bail in the sum of \$5,000 to appear for examination, and \$2,500 to refrain from violating the neutrality laws. They were unable to procure bail, and were remanded to jail.
