Particulars of the Late Estile at Partie Padre-Complete Victory of the Patriete-Large Force of Filibusters Gone from the South. WASHINGTON, June 28, 1862. Despatches received in this city to-night from Cuba

give further particulars of the fight near Puerto del Padro between the Cubana, under General Marmol, and the Spaniards, under General Ferrer. The victory of the Cubana was complete. The Cubans captured an extensive trait, containing a large amount of provisions, ammunition, clothing and hospital stores. The loss of the Spaniards was over 200 killed. A number of Americals participated in the

fight.

Information has also been received that the troops
which have been concentrating for some time on the
Southern coast, numbering over 1,800 men, have all
lett for Cuba, and it is believed ther have successfully landed.
