**Particulars of the Late Battle at Padre Pa-  
dre—Complete Victory of the Patriots—Large  
Force of Filibusters Gone from the South.**

WASHINGTON, June 26, 1862.

Despatches received in this city to-night from Cuba give further particulars of the fight near Puerto del Padre between the Cubans, under General Marmol, and the Spaniards, under General Ferrer. The victory of the Cubans was complete. The Cubans captured an extensive train, containing a large amount of provisions, ammunition, clothing and hospital stores. The loss of the Spaniards was over 200 killed. A number of Americans participated in the fight.

Information has also been received that the troops which have been concentrating for some time on the Southern coast, numbering over 1,800 men, have all left for Cuba, and it is believed they have successfully landed.
