MARYLAND. Condemnation in the United States Court of the Steamship Caba. BALTHORE, June 23, 1889. In the United States District Court this morning

Judge Giles delivered an oral opinion in the case of the United States vs. the steamship Onbs, libelled on information of having brought on the voyage from Havana 44,000 cigars not piaced on the manifest. After reviewing the testimony adduced and the facts presented in the case Judge Giles decided

the facts presented in the case Indge Glies decided that the steamer, under the acts of Congress relating to commerce with foreign countries, was clearly lable to foreithre, and that he would sign a decree of condemnation and foreithre. The counsel for
