Effect of Dulce's Resignation as Captain General of Cuba.

MADRID, June 5, 1869.

Admiral Topete read General Dulce's telegrams announcing his resignation as Captain General of Cuba before the Constituent Cortes last evening. Great excitement prevailed. Marshal Serrano asked for a suspension of judgment until the arrival of General Dulce and until the particulars in the matter were known. It is rumored that General Dulce was recalled on account of his leniency to the Cuban insurgents.
