An English War Ship at Havana—Estates Embargoed.

HAVANA, July 17, 1860.

An English war ship has arrived here from Nassau.

The steamship Louisiana, of the Havana and St. Nazaire line, arrived here this morning.

The estates of Miguel, Domingo and Aldamas have been embargoed.

Sugar is firm at $8\frac{1}{4}$ a $8\frac{3}{4}$ reals for No. 10 to 12 Dutch standard. Muscovadoes—A small business doing and prices unchanged. Exchange on the United States, short sight, in gold, 5 a 6 per cent premium.
