A Second Government Loan—The Captain General Annuls an Article of His Late Proclamation—The United States Doing His Work.

HAVANA, July 20, 1869.

The Spanish Bank is about to issue notes for a second government loan. The journals are engaged in discussing the financial situation.

Captain General de Rodas, in view of the prompt action of the United States in arresting the filibusters, has issued a decree annulling article seven of his proclamation of the 7th inst. relative to the right of Spanish cruisers to search neutral vessels in waters near Cuba.
