## Release of American Prisoners—Rebel Estates Embargoed—Cuban Prisoners at Fernando Po.

HAYANA, July 22, 1862.

Two citizens of the United States, named Printado and Cablas, who have been in prison since February, and Señor Gutierrez, a Mexican, have been released, through the intercession of the American Consul General.

The splendid Aldamas mansion, in this city, confiscated by the government, has been turned into a casino for the officers of the volunteers.

The total number of estates belonging to the rebels which have been embargoed by the government up to the present date is 1,200.

Advices from Fernando Po represent that the Cuban prisoners there are in good health.

The steamer Eagle arrived last night from New York.
