## Europe.

The cable despatches are dated July 27.

Mr. Gladstone is reported unwell and unable to attend to his duties. Parliament will be prorogued on December 10. A fault has been discovered in the Atlantic cable of 1866. The Harvard crew were out yesterday and their style of rowing caused a favorable impression, although their pace was considered rather slow.

The Carlists have again been defeated at Tarascon, and General Espartero has added his name to the public offers of assistance to the government of Spain.

Baron von Beust, at the reception of the Hungarian delegation of the Budget Committee, made a most telling speech, and regretted that Prussia had not met his endeavors to establish more cordial relations between the two countries.

## Cuba.

The Governor of Trinidad has ordered all Spaniards between the ages of fifteen and sixty to do military duty. The press favor extending the system to the whole island. The Tuscarora is off Havana.
