de Redas Preciains the Redaction of the Insurrection—Captured Insurgents to be Fairly Tried by Courts Martial or by Civil Tribanals.

HAYANA, July 7, 1899.
Captain General de Rodas has issued an important proclamation. He states that the insurrection has been reduced in extent, and is now carried on by parties of guerillas. He declares that parties arrested for pubbery, arson or murder shall be tried by court martial, while in other cases the civil tribunals shall continue to exercise their functions;

and he declares that the accused may rely upon receiving imparital justice.
