Reported Defeat of General Jordan and Capture of His Convoy--A Spanish Story About Poisoning.

HAVANA, August 13, 1893.

Count Valmaseda captured near Remancuanagua a rebel convoy, General Jordan commanding, which was moving towards Holguin. The rebels took to flight after a short fight, and their commander escaped. This is considered the most important capture of the war.

The authorities of Santi Espiritu report that a rebel plot to poison the bread used by the inhabitants on a certain day has been discovered, and a number of suspected parties have been arrested.
