Plot to Poison the Garrison at Matanzas—
Rumored Defeat of the Revolutionists.

HAVANA, August 14, 1869.

A plan has been disclosed in Matanzas to poison the bread intended for the garrison at that place. A negro made known the plot to the authorities, who had the party arrested, tried and sentenced.

There is a rumor in circulation that Colonel Quiros had attacked the insurgents at Sitio, and killed ninety. The Spanish loss is small. This report is probably confounded with the capture of General Jordan's convoy, as the localities of each of the engagements are contiguous.
