

Cuba.

The embargo at Havana on the telegraphic news reports has been removed by direction of the Captain General. Despatches state that Jordan's command has been driven to the mountains and that the Manzanillo, Bayamo and Jiguani districts are completely under Spanish control. Letters received in Washington, however, say that the Spaniards were completely whipped by Jordan's command near Holguin and lost 170 killed and about 700 wounded or deserted. Many slaves are joining the Cubans. General Quesada is about to attack Nuevitas, and a fleet of transports is assembling in front of the town to remove the Spanish garrison.
