**The Casino Espanol Opened—Conscription in the Districts—The Volunteers Enthusiastic—Miscellaneous News.**

HAVANA, August 16, 1892.

The *Casino Espanol* was opened last night with much ceremony and festivity. The Captain General was present.

Colonel Palacios, late Governor of Manzanillo, sailed for Spain yesterday.

The Governor of Santi Espiritu has ordered a conscription, to include all men within his jurisdiction between the ages of twenty and fifty-five. He has also prohibited the sale of groceries and provisions for the interior, with a view of cutting off one source of rebel supply.

Nearly 1,500 men were obtained by the conscription in the jurisdiction of Trinidad. They are employed in guarding the larger States in the interior.

A band of robbers have plundered and burned several houses near Macagua.

The volunteers in Havana are very enthusiastic, and are ready to take the field.

Heavy rains are falling daily, and the thermometer marks ninety-eight degrees night and day.

Sickness is decreasing, owing to the fact that unacclimated persons have now passed through the worst of the vomito season.

The steamer *Mariposa* sailed yesterday.

The steamer *Liberty* arrived at noon to-day, from Baltimore.
