Advises received in Washington say that the volunteers are exercising the same control over De Rodas that they did over Dulce. De Rodas is uneasy at their domineering ways and fierce demands and will probably resign soon. An organization of Spaniards favorable to Cespedes, and intended mainly to defeat the designs of the volunteers, has been exposed by a spy, and many members of it have been compelled to take refuge in the Cuban ranks.
