tion there:-The volunteers are exhibiting the purmoses of their organization-that of seizing the government of the Island of Cuba from Spain. Everywhere throughout the island the volunteer juntas are acting in concert with the avuntamiento at Hawans, and now exercise the same control over Rodas that expelled Dulce from his position. It is reported that a formidable organization of Spaniards in the Interest of the Cespedes government in every part of the island has been exposed through the means of a spy. The object of this organization was to sonnteract that of the volunteers and to strengthen the Cubans in the field in the means necessary to carry on the contest. This they did, but the expose them a moral and physical power which will be a terror to the Spanish troops and volunteers as or-ganized on the island. It is reported that the Rodas contemplates resigning and returning to Spain. believing that his longer continuance in his present sition would detract from his well carned re-

antation.
