

Cuba.

Señor Lemos, the Cuban agent, is patiently waiting the result of the propositions submitted by Minister Siskles to Spain for the purchase of Cuba. The Caspedes government has assented to the proposition, and, in case it is rejected, propose to render Cuba utterly uninhabitable rather than submit to Spanish dominion.

Sixteen hundred insurgents are reported to have returned to Spanish allegiance near Holguin and in the Cinco Villas district. The Spanish Bank has again tendered a donation for the support of the volunteers. Valmaseda is being reinforced and a decisive battle with General Jordan is expected daily. General Ryan is in Canada, where he was recently joined by two officers direct from Cuba.
