**The Throne Question—An Appointment for Cuba—Prim's Visit to Paris.**

MADRID, August 23, 1862.

The Epoch of to-day says that the most probable candidate for the Spanish throne is Augustus of Portugal.

At Barcelona a movement is on foot to make Marshal Serrano King of Spain.

General Carbo has been appointed Lieutenant Governor of Cuba.

There will be no further trials by the council of war for conspiracy against the life of Prim.

General Escalante is dead.

There is much speculation here as to General Prim's journey to Paris. It is supposed the object is to correct Olozaga's deficiencies and confer with Napoleon on the situation.

The Count of Chesse has been restored to his rank and pay, on condition that he go to the Canaries. He gave his parole to remain at Puerto Real till the vessel was ready; but he broke the parole and fled to France, whereby he forfeited rank and pay.
