## Movements of the Patriots in the Jurisdiction of Colon—Spanish Reports of Spanish Victories.

HAVANA, August 30, 1869.

Letters from the jurisdiction of Colon state that the insurgents left that quarter, going eastward and taking with them all the slaves of the San Antonio estate.

Governor Trillo, of Sagua la Grande, surprised the insurgents at Encrucijala and killed twelve of them.

A *Te Deum* is ordered to be sung in the churches of Puerto Principe for the disappearance of the cholera.

Captain Urcola, with one hundred men, killed ten insurgents and took thirteen prisoners near Cubitas, in the jurisdiction of Puerto Principe.

The *Diario's* editorial semi-monthly review of the situation for the Spanish steamer regrets its inability to send flattering notices regarding the suppression of the insurrection, but reiterates the statement that the Spaniards are completely in the ascendancy in seven jurisdictions of the Eastern and Central Departments.
