General Lesca and the Volunteers—Flight at Sevilla Bay.

HAVANA, Sept. 9, 1869.

General Lesca left the city at noon to-day for Sagua, with the new battalion of volunteers, 400 strong.

A detachment of 200 Spaniards met the insurgents in Sevilla Bay and put them to flight.

In a skirmish near Ramon thirty rebels are reported to have been killed.
