

## MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS.

### **Board of Aldermen.**

The Board met yesterday afternoon, pursuant to adjournment, with the president, Alderman Coman, in the chair. Several papers were introduced, relating principally to the regulating and paving of streets, and were referred to the appropriate committees. A resolution introduced in July last, expressing the sympathy felt for the struggling Cubans, was called up by Alderman Hardy. An additional resolution was added, on motion of Alderman Hardy, requesting the representatives in Congress from this city to urge upon Congress at its session the propriety of at once recognizing the independence of the island of Cuba.

The action of the Board of Assistant Aldermen in the appointment of several commissioners of deeds was concurred in, after which the meeting adjourned until Thursday next at two P. M.
