Five Cubans arrived at Nassau on the 22d from Quezada's camp with \$20,000 to purchase arms and other munitions of war. They have despatches for the Cuban Junta which state that the fight at Las Tunas was a patriot victory, and fifteen Spanish officers were captured and immediately shot.

Havana despatches state that the Spanish prospects in the Eastern Department are flattering. Several Cubans are presenting themselves for pardon. The Havana journals say Minister Sickles ought to occupy a position more worthy of his abilities than that of Minister to Spain.
