

From the letter of our Cuban correspondent on the Electoral Question, we learn that Cuba has not, as Gen. Dulce recently announced, received the same rights as any other province of Spain. On the contrary, in so important a question as that of suffrage, the Cubans have been greatly wronged. While in Spain every 25,000 inhabitants elect a deputy, in Cuba only one deputy is given to every 100,000 inhabitants. In Spain the suffrage is free; in Cuba it is conditional upon the payment of a tax. Thus Spain, instead of adopting reconciliatory measures, widens the breach which already exists between her and Cuba.
