

The Captain-General of Cuba has issued a proclamation withdrawing the offer of an amnesty which he had made to the insurgents, suppressing liberty of the press, and establishing in its place the former censorship. The fact of such a proclamation being issued is a clear indication that the Captain-General sees that all his offers have failed to produce any effect, and that he is alarmed at the prospects of the revolution. The result of the new proclamation, we expect, will soon be found to be very different from that expected by the Captain-General.
