THE PROPOSED DIRECTORY—RE-ENFORCEMENTS FOR CUBA.

MADRID, Feb. 2.—It is probable that Marshal Prim, Gen. Serrano, and Señor Rivero will constitute the proposed Directory. All those opposed to the monarchy base their hopes on the permanence of the Directory when once established. Reinforcements to the number of 5,000 men sailed last week for Havana.

RETURN OF THE PAPAL NUNCIO—THE ENDOW- MENT OF THE CLERGY AND THE ARMY BUDGET TO BE REDUCED.

Monsignor Franche, the Papal Nuncio, departed from Madrid last Sunday, on his way to Rome, but explanations having been made, he has been induced to return, and was to-day received by the Governor of the City, and conducted to his official residence. The Cortes will probably make great reductions in the endowment of the clergy and in the expenditure for the army.
