REPORTED SURRENDER OF GEN. CESPEDES AND
AGUILERA—ASSASSINATION OF GEN. ARANGO.

HAVANA, Feb. 4.—For several days a rumor has been current that the revolutionary Gen. Céspedes and Aguilera have surrendered to Count Valmaseda, but the report proves untrue. No news has been received from the Eastern Department. The journals of Havana have refrained for the past week from publishing news from the seat of war, and it appears as if there was a tacit understanding not to inform the people as to the condition of affairs. The *Diario* of to-day says that Gen. Augustin Arango of the revolutionary forces has been assassinated by his companions.
