THE STEAMER COMANDITARIO—SEVEN CUBANS EXECUTED—ARRIVAL OF FRESH TROOPS.

HAVANA, April 1.—The steamer Comanditario has arrived at Nassau, and her captors, at last accounts, had abandoned her and gone ashore. She will probably be taken possession of and brought back to Havana by a Spanish man-of-war. The Spanish war steamer Guadalquiver found a schooner abandoned near Signano, and took her to Batatano. This schooner is supposed to be the vessel which recently landed a cargo of arms on the coast near Cienfoego. In the Sagua district, seven incendiaries were caught and were executed on the plantations which they had destroyed. Fresh troops from Spain arrived and disembarked this morning.
