### THE CASE OF THE AMERICAN CITIZEN CASANOVA.

WASHINGTON, April 5.—In answer to a dispatch, sent on Saturday from the State Department, Acting Consul-General Hall telegraphs from Havana that the case of imprisonment of Don Inocencio Casanova, an American citizen, is undergoing examination, and he hopes Casanova will be released. He has made a full report to the Department.

### ARRIVAL OF THE COMANDITARIO.

HAVANA, April 5.—The Spanish man-of-war Quintin arrived in the harbor this morning with the steamer Comanditario. The steamer was recaptured at Sturup Key. The Cubans had left the vessel, and taken refuge on shore. Of the crew four firemen have been brought here prisoners, and a Spanish war steamer has two other prisoners. It is stated that two of the Cubans were drowned while attempting to escape from the Comanditario.
