

Gen. Lelona has been imprisoned by his garrison at Puerto-Principe, and the Captain-General, in a speech counseling moderation, has denied reports of his intention to act barbarously. Another expedition for Cuba, by way of Canada, is reported. The Republicans of New-Castile have directed a manifesto against the reactionary tendencies of the Spanish Ministry, and assert the right to revolt. Carlisle are in insurrection at Vittoria. While the English Peers are still deliberating the question of disendowment, the Bahamans have settled it by the passage of a bill in accordance with the most radical parts of Gladstone's measure. In the House of Lords, a proposed amendment to the Church bill, to give grants to Catholics and Presbyterians, has been defeated.

There are further developments of bounty frauds on Indian soldiers. Four or five persons have been drowned by a steamboat collision near Cleveland. The coal miners' strike is partially over; half the mines will be at work next week. Hildebrand, the Missouri outlaw, reported murderer of eighty persons, is said to be dead. By the fall of a bridge near Richmond, yesterday, J. R. Dauch, candidate for State Senator, was killed, and seven colored men were fatally hurt. A French corvette at Fortress Monroe has lost several men by yellow fever.

Ketchum yesterday cut short an elaborate opinion by Judge Barnard in favor of his liberation by refusing to be set free. Kings County Supervisors propose to enlarge the Brooklyn Jail. McVeany, elected Assistant Alderman, and so declared by the courts, asks a mandamus to get the seat refused by the Board. The Gay et. homicide is decided to be no homicide, the victim dying of rum disease. There was a general shuffling of Police captains and sergeants yesterday. Packard's Business College Commencement yesterday developed some novel and valuable ideas on education.
