Gen. Goicouria, the alleged hero of a recent expedition supposed to be for Cuba, and the subject of a legal question of considerable interest, was vesterday discharged from Court amid great cheering. We extend to the General our congratulations. It was his lot to find himself almost betrayed to the sharp vigilance of Spain-it is his better luck to escape. We are glad that the evidence did not happen, to use the words of the United States Commissioner, "to bring him within the "fair view of the law" as a manifest perpetra-

tor of overt acts.
