FROM CUBA.

HAVANA, Dec. 4.—Advices from Puerto Principe to the 21th of November, are received, containing some details of the attack on San Jose garrisoned by Catalonian volunteers. A party of twenty volunteers sent out to reconnoitre was captured, and next morning the insurgents attacked San Jose. They fought desperately and endeavored to scale the entrenchments but the garrison receiving reinforcements, they finally retired. Eleven Catalonians were killed. A military government will soon be inaugurated in the Cinco Villas District. Great results are expected from this measure which it is supposed will lead to the complete reestablishment of Spanish authority in that quarter.
