

FROM CUBA.

HAVANA, August 30th.—Domingo Terrera, a member of the Vigilance Committee, appointed by the Government to enforce the collection of customs, has been dismissed for engaging in contraband traffic.

Letters from the Jurisdiction of Colon state that the insurgents have left that quarter, going east, taking with them all the slaves of the San Antonio estate.

Gov. Trillo, in Saguala Grande, surprised the insurgents at Caguages, and killed 12 men.

Te Deum is ordered to be sung in the churches of Puerto Principe for the disappearance of the cholera.

Capt. Urcola, with 100 men, killed 10 insurgents and took 13 prisoners, near Cubitas in the Jurisdiction of Puerto Principe.

The *Diario* in an editorial semi-monthly review of the situation from the Spanish standpoint, regrets its inability to send flattering notices regarding the suppression of the insurrection, but reiterates the Spaniards are completely in the ascendency in seven Jurisdictions of the Eastern and Central Departments.
