HAVANA, May 3.—The journals of this city to-day announce that the insurgents have appeared in the jurisdiction of Cinco Villas and the surrounding country.

Under the Confiscation decree, many large plantations and country estates have been seized by officers of the government.

New York, May 3.—A special to the Herald, dated Havana, April 30, says: "The revolutionary party held a grand congress at Sibarreon on the 13th instant, at which thirty representives were present from all parts of the Island. Cespedes presided."

The congress unanimously adopted resolutions declaring that the revolutionary party is fighting for independence from Spain and annexation to the United States.

Quesada was again elected Generalissimo of the revolutionary armies. The delegates were enthusiastic, sanguine, and determined.

A report comes from Puerto Principe that the Spanish troops have captured Betancourt and other members of the revolutionary committee.
