

A Key West letter says news has reached there from Cuba, announcing that the revolutionists had surprised Cienfuegos and had seized a large quantity of provisions, clothing and medicines, and had retired in good order.

Intercepted letters from Spanish officers say there are no prospects of suppressing the rebellion.

The *Times* Havana letter says that in Canso Villas district the troops are massing and there will be sufficient to draw a regular cordon across the island, which will compel the insurgents to abandon the country or force them to a battle, in which they will have no chance against disciplined soldiers.
