**CUBA.**—The insurgents in the neighborhood of Sagua la Grande, numbering some 1,500, are under the command of Rudolph Pale, an American, and formerly in the Confederate service. Advice from the interior state that Government troops are advancing against the rebels in every direction. In the attempts made by the Government forces to re-establish communications between Nuevitas and Puerto Principe, several skirmishes had taken place, in one of which, according to Government reports, 175 insurgents had been killed. The insurgents who sustained defeat at Mayari were at last accounts moving toward Holquiere. Planters and merchants are dissatisfied with the proclamation issued by the insurgents.

A steam transport has arrived at Havana with 1,100 Spanish troops. Considerable military activity is displayed in the Central and Eastern Departments, and skirmishes are of frequent occurrence in various parts of the island.
