

CUBA.—The insurgents have possession of the town of Fnunclydado, on the railroad between Villa Clara and Cienfuegos, and a body of them have appeared in the neighborhood of Sagua la Grande. Quesada, at the head of seven regiments, is threatening Villa Clara. Outbreaks are reported at Cienfuegos, Santa Spiritu and Trinidad, and are momentarily expected in the immediate neighborhood of Havana. The insurgent chiefs refuse to treat for surrender. Arango is now reported to have been murdered by Spanish troops in breach of truce. The Government organs in Havana favor a war of extermination and the enforcement of loans if necessary. Two companies of regulars had left Matanzas for Managua. Recruiting for the volunteer service continues briskly. Arrests are still made in Havana and the police continue to search houses.
