## CUBAN AFFAIRS.

Arrival of Soldiers from Spain—De Rodas to Remain on the Island — Military Changes and Movements,

HAVANA, Nov. 3.—The steamer Morro Casile arrived here Wednesday night....Two steamers from Spain with 1,500 soldiers have arrived ....Gen. DE RODAS remains Captain-General of the island. The report of his departure is unfounded....In the Vuelta Abajos heavy winds prevailed and caused much havo ag....Gen. CARO, commanding the Con-Department, goes to Spain; ZEAS, chief of DE Rodas' staff, will assume that command. Goveneous relieves Merts in the command of Santiago de Cuba. The insurgent leaders Cuerto and Rodriguez Tea were killed at the Cienaga de Zapato. RAMON ARMAS and JOSE NODAL were captured at Cimarrones. The Counterguerrillas operating in the mountains have captured and killed the Cuban General GABRIEL FORTUN, an important personage of the rebellion, and fifteen others. It is reported that the Cuban General Porro and others attempted to leave the country. They had already embarked, when they were prevented from departing by their own partisans....The Panama and West Indies Cable expedition has left Aspinwall, and is expected momentarily at Holland Bay, Jamaica.
