Denial at Madrid of Any Proposal to Sell Cuba—Additional Troops Sent to the Island—Sir George Jenkinson not Drowned—Commercial Failure—Marine Disaster.

MADRID, Nov. 7.—The *Correspondencia* newspaper denies the statements made in the New-York *Herald*, on the 17th ult., and the *Sun*, on the 19th, relative to the sale of Cuba. The *Correspondencia* is the organ of Señor MORET, the Minister of the Colonies, and its utterances on this question may therefore be regarded as official. The journal adds that the Spanish people would not permit the sale of Cuba to the United States or any other nation on any terms.... Reinforcements to the number of 9,000 men are preparing to leave for Cuba.
