Cuban League of the United States.

On the 7th of February, at a meeting at Delmonico's, in New-York, an association was organized, under the name of the Cubau League, for the purpose expressed in the following resolution:

Resolved, That this organization be called "The Cuban League offthe United States," and that its purpose shall be to give practical consolidation to the sentiment of American citizens, and the moral support of the same, in securing to Cuba, by all legal means, the inalienable right of self-government.
