THE WEST INDIES.

A Discussion on Lerandi in Cuba-Removal of Puello-Tonnage Dues in Jamaica.

HAVANA, March 31.—The Vox de Cuba pub-Lished a bitter article against LERSUNDI, whereupon the Prensa, which was about to unite with the Voz, denounces it, and declares it cannot join a journal which attacks such a patriot as Lersun-DI. The Diario also defends Lersundi, repelling the idea that he ever had any connection with a plan to erect Cuba into a Province independent or opposed to the present Government. Rebels continue to surrender themselves in the Central Department. Skirmishes are reported Nuevitas. Gen. Arango has issued a manifesto to the people declaring that the revolution has no reason to exist today, and advising his countrymen to lay down their arms. Gen. PUELLO has been relieved of his command. His successor has not yet been announced.
