Arrival of the Cable Fleet at Cienfuegos—The Work to Commence at Once—Important News of the Revolution.

HAVANA, July 11.—A telegraphic dispatch from Cienfuegos, announces the arrival at that port, yesterday, of the Panama and West India Cable Company's steamers *Dacia* and *Suffolk*, and the British man-of-war *Vestal*. The work of laying the cable will be immediately commenced by the *Dacia* and *Suffolk*....During an engagement lately, near Moron, between the Spaniards and insurgents, Lieut. PATINO, of the Spanish army, and eighteen soldiers were killed. Seventeen insurgents were also killed. Col. NOVAL attacked this same body of insurgents on the 7th inst., killing thirty-one of their number....Great excitement exists throughout the island over European complications.
