Engagements Between Spanish Troops and the Insurgents—Officers Captured and Killed.

HAVANA, Aug. 23.—The *Gaceta* of today contains the following official intelligence: CANIZAL'S corps disembarked at Camaniquan and attacked the insurgents, capturing Gen. PEDRO FIGUEREDO, the Assistant Secretary of War, Gen. RODRIGO TAMAYO and his son, and killing twenty of the rebels. The salt deposits at that place were destroyed. FIGUEREDO and TAMAYO, and his son were taken to Santiago de Cuba and executed. Major QUESADA killed twenty-two insurgents near Holguin, including Gen. FRANCISCO PERALTA, Col. JAIME MORENO, MARIA TAMAYO FLEITES, and his son FERNANDO. The insurgents Gen. ANGEL FIGUEREDO and Col. FERNANDEZ were captured at Jiguani and executed at Bayamo. Capts. CAMACHO and IGARRA are also prisoners, awaiting trial. Col. BONICHE reports having attacked the forces of MAXIMO GOMEZ in the Sierra Maestra, and killing eighty-seven insurgents, including Capts. LEIVA and PANCHO VEGA. Col. MARIN report the killing of the insurgent chief, GRAU, and fourteen men, near Las Tunas. JOSE VIDAL, a planter of Mayari, was killed near Holguin. The operations of the Spanish troops are being continued.
