KEY WEST.

The town has been in a state of excitoment the whole day in consequence of the killing of Gonzalo Castanon, the editor of the Voz de Cuba, who arrived here on the 22th, accompanied by four Spaniards, with the intention of fighting a duel with the Cuban editor of the Republicano, published here. Señor Castanon, while standing on the porch of his hotel with some frends, was approached by a several

armed Cubans, and a fight ensued between the adherons of both parties. Pistols were freely used on both aides, several shous being directed towards Gastanon. He returned the fire and had wounded one of his assailants, when he received a shoir from which he died in fifteen minutes atterwards. One of the Spaniards was slightly wounded, and among the Oubans there was one scrionar and

All of the cubans were fully armed.
