are still confined in it is not known what their ultimate fate will be. On Sunday last two cannons, which had been discoyered near Cobre. were brought into town with much ceremony. The escort which brought them into Cobre had an engagement with the insurrents, who tried to regain po-session of the cannon, and indicted some loss on the troops, although the precise details cannot be got at. Yesterday funeral bonors for the repose of Castanon's soul were calebrated, the day being observed as a semi-holiday. The sloop Champion, Captain Cox, mentioned in my last as having been detuned by the authorities on suspicion, has been abandoned by her captain, and, being very leaky, has sunk as far as the depth of water in which she is moored will allow her.
