the attempted assassination of a Cuban a few days since, and that a number of armed Spaniards who recently arrived from Hayana are supposed to be implicated in the outrage. This business of Spaniards coming across from Hayana to American soil for the purpose of indulging in a little blood-letting has gone far enough. There are sufficient opportunities for that kind of work in Cuba

for both Spaniards and Cubans. We want no more such scenes as those which resulted in the death of Selor Castanon. Armed Spaniards had better remain nearer Havana than Key West and select other than American

soil for lawless deeds.

DISGRACEFUL SCENES IN KEY WEST.—A special telegram from Key West informs us of
