## CUBA. Successful Landing of an Expedition Near Nuovitae-Hard Fighting Near Manati-The Spaniards Boaten-Cholers.

VIA KEY WEST, March 25, 1870.

Advices from Naevitas up to the 22th inst. state that fillousters had effected a landing near Nuevas Grandes. Troops were telegraphed for from Paerio Principe. They arrived at Nuevitas on the 19th and were immediately started in pursuit of the invaders.

Two gunboats had sailed for Nueras Grandes to cut of the retreat by sea if any was attemp ted. flard fighting was reported near the town of Manatt. No details had been received. The troops must have lost heavily, as the Spaniards at Neuvi as beemed much depressed. Contern prevails to a serious extent at San Mignal

and Baga.
