Official Report of an Attempted Invasion of the Jurisdiction of Bayamo-The Insurgents Repulsed as Usual-And are Utterly Disorganized. HAVANA, April 18, 1870. The Captain General telegraphs from Puerto Principe that the insurgent forces under the command of Maximo Gomez and Modesto Diaz made an attempt to pass the lines of Valmaseda's division at Canto Abajo with the object of invading the jurisdiction of Bayamo. They were met by two Spanish battalions and repulsed with the loss of 170 killed.

The rebels fied in great confusion, and at last accounts were utterly disorganized.
